The area's attractions include its beaches and golf courses, as well as a number of amusement parks, an aquarium, Legends In Concert, retail developments, a number of shopping complexes and over 1,900 restaurants including seafood restaurants. The area also has dinner theaters, nightclubs, and many tourist shops. Also in the city is Myrtle Waves, one of the largest water parks on the East Coast of the United States. The Carolina Opry is another highly acclaimed attraction, which features various musical, comedy, dance, and entertainment shows.

The Myrtle Beach Boardwalk opened in 2010 and has been recognized as the nation's #3 boardwalk by National Geographic and one of the best US boardwalks by Travel + Leisure magazine. It has just under a mile of Grand Strand beach and is a prime location for camping, swimming, hiking, biking, and fishing. Pier 14 Restaurant by the Boardwalk, Broadway at the Beach, being one of the best and most popular shopping malls with many restaurants just off US 17N and Barefoot Landing. Just South of Myrtle Beach SC is Brooke Green Gardens.

The Dick Robinson Memorial Baseball Field at Midway University in Midway, KY

Mates Brad Bain and Mike Robinson have brought to my attention that Midway University located close to Lexington, KY where Mate Dick Robinson was on the faculty and started their Sports Management Program is planning a new baseball field to honor Dick Robinson as the Dick Robinson Memorial Baseball Field. Mate Mike Robinson who was a past President of the MI Jaycees and NVP, notes that they have already raised a substantial amount through Dick's Kentucky friends, Jaycees, JCI Senators, and business associates and wanted me to share this opportunity with the rest of his past Jaycee Friends nationwide.

Mate Dick Robinson was President of the US Jaycees in 1975/76 from MI and touched the lives of so many Jaycees. After his year of President of the U.S. Jaycees, Dick moved to Lexington, Kentucky, and immediately became involved in the community. One of his many achievements was to design, implement, and teach the first sports management program at Midway University. Dick was very involved in local athletics and was a baseball scout, sports agent, and avid sports enthusiast and avid golfer. This year will be 7 years since we lost our good friend and past Jaycee leader in a tragic bicycle accident. However, we do know that he is still missed by family and many friends and Jaycees who had the good fortune of being a part of his life.

Midway University is currently undergoing a major capital campaign to build new dormitories, classrooms, expand the student center and with the centerpiece of this expansion being a baseball field named in honor of Dick Robinson. The total cost of the Dick Robinson Memorial Baseball Field is \$1 million dollars. To date the University has raised 75% of the funds needed to build the field. Hopefully with additional financial support over the next 6 months, the ground-breaking ceremony and dedication of the Dick Robinson Memorial Baseball field will take place

This has been customary since the inception of The CREW of the SS Fellowship. **NOTE:** Remember one cannot buy ones way into the CREW of the SS Fellowship and must be nominated by a current Mate.
